HJR1063

The Oklahoma Sovereignty Protection Act - Did not make it out of Rules and is Dead.

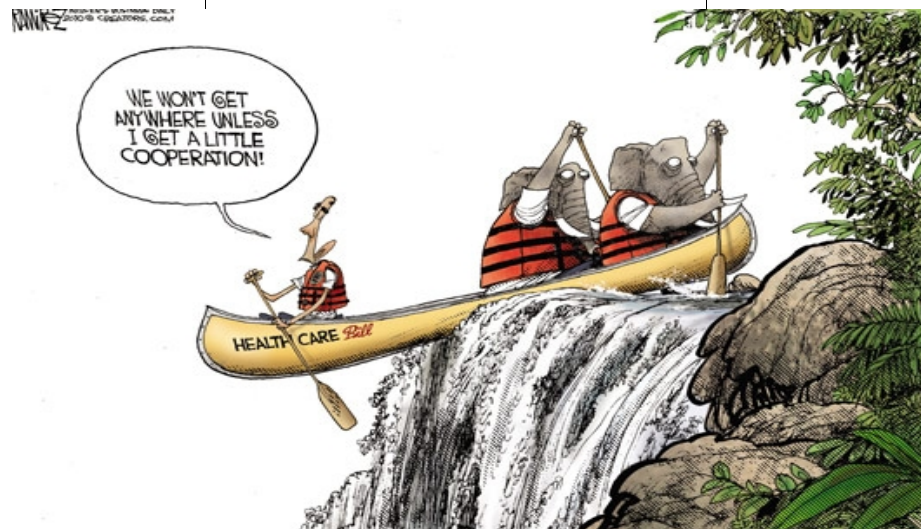


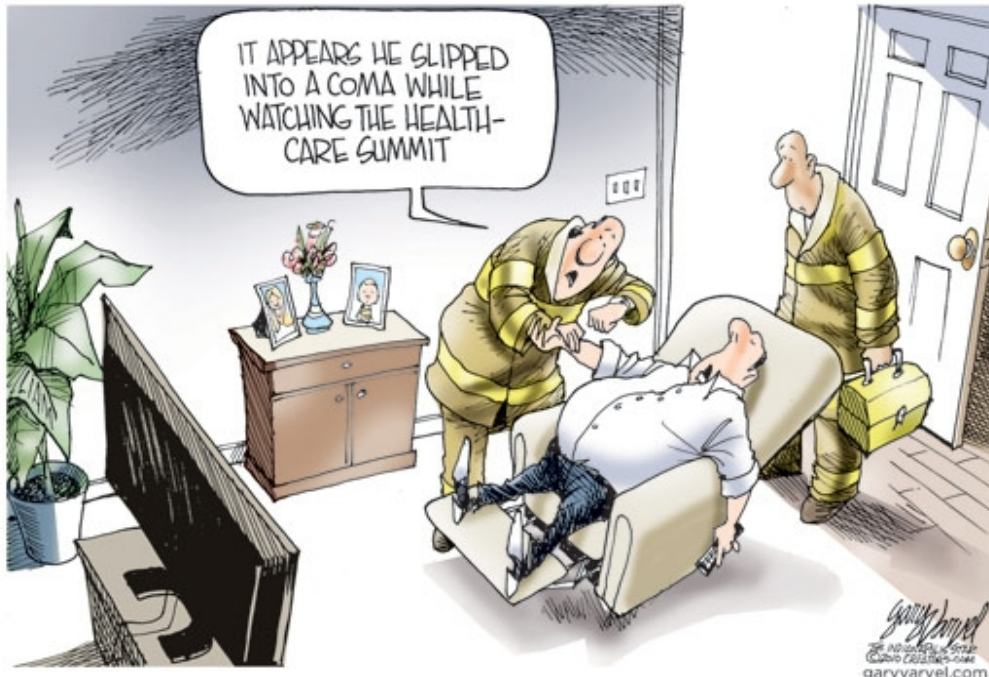
